

10 Steps for a Successful Field Trip

1. Fill out the Check In Card before arriving at the Park.
2. Enter through the Bus Entrance, just south of the Main Entrance.
3. After checking in, wait in your assigned spot in the Train Depot Parking Lot for all of your group to catch up.
4. A Naturalist will get on the lead bus and direct you to your assigned unloading spot by the Visitors Center.
5. Chaperones will then park your cars in the main lot and meet your group where they are unloading.
6. Naturalist will explain Park rules before you get off the bus.
7. Lead Teacher will take the Check In Card and payment to the Visitors Center.
8. Once unloaded, buses are to be parked in designated Bus Parking under the power lines.
9. If you have a scheduled animal program, arrive at Forest Hall 10-15minutes before the program begins.
10. To pack up for the day, pull up in the same spot you unloaded in when you arrived.

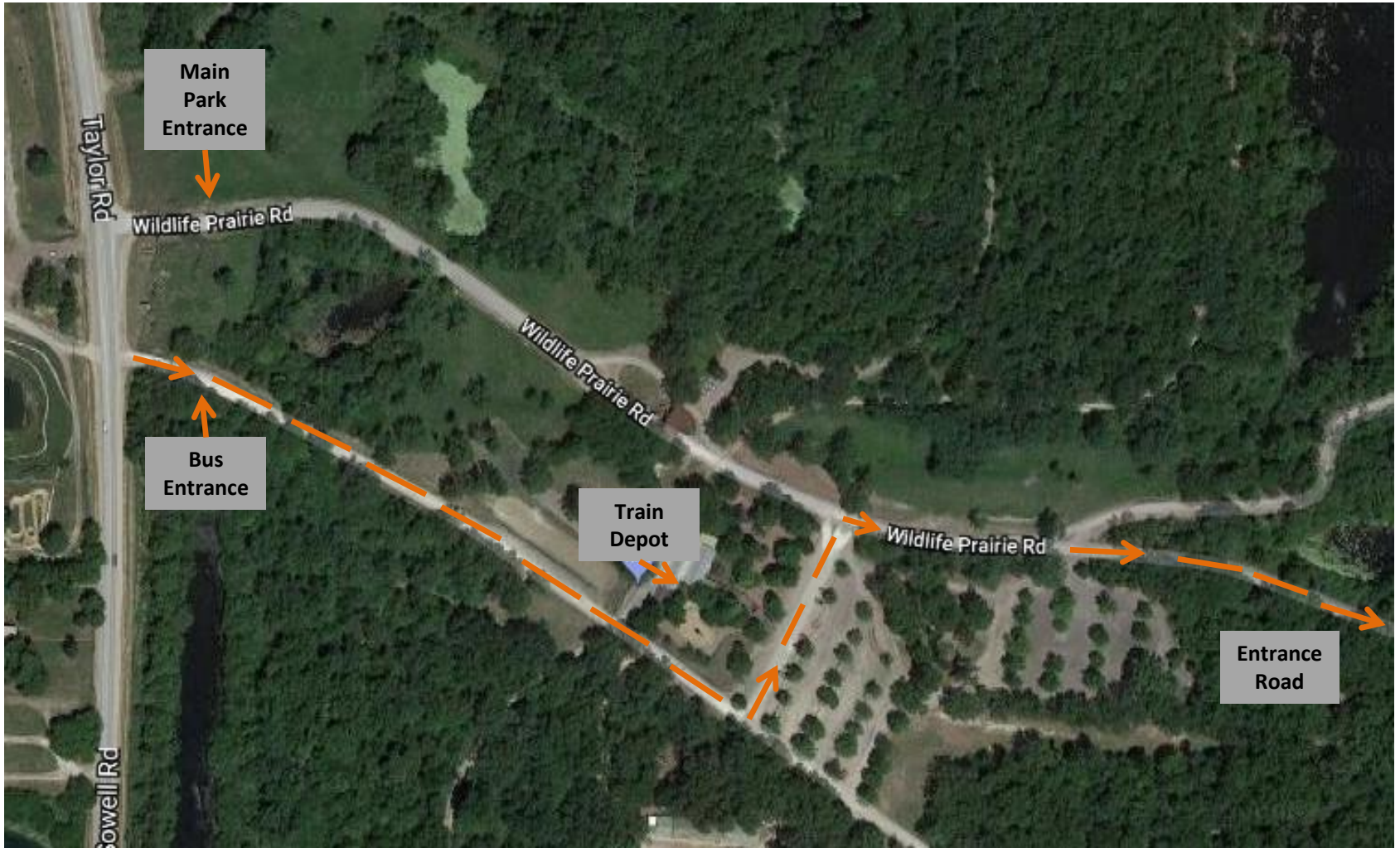

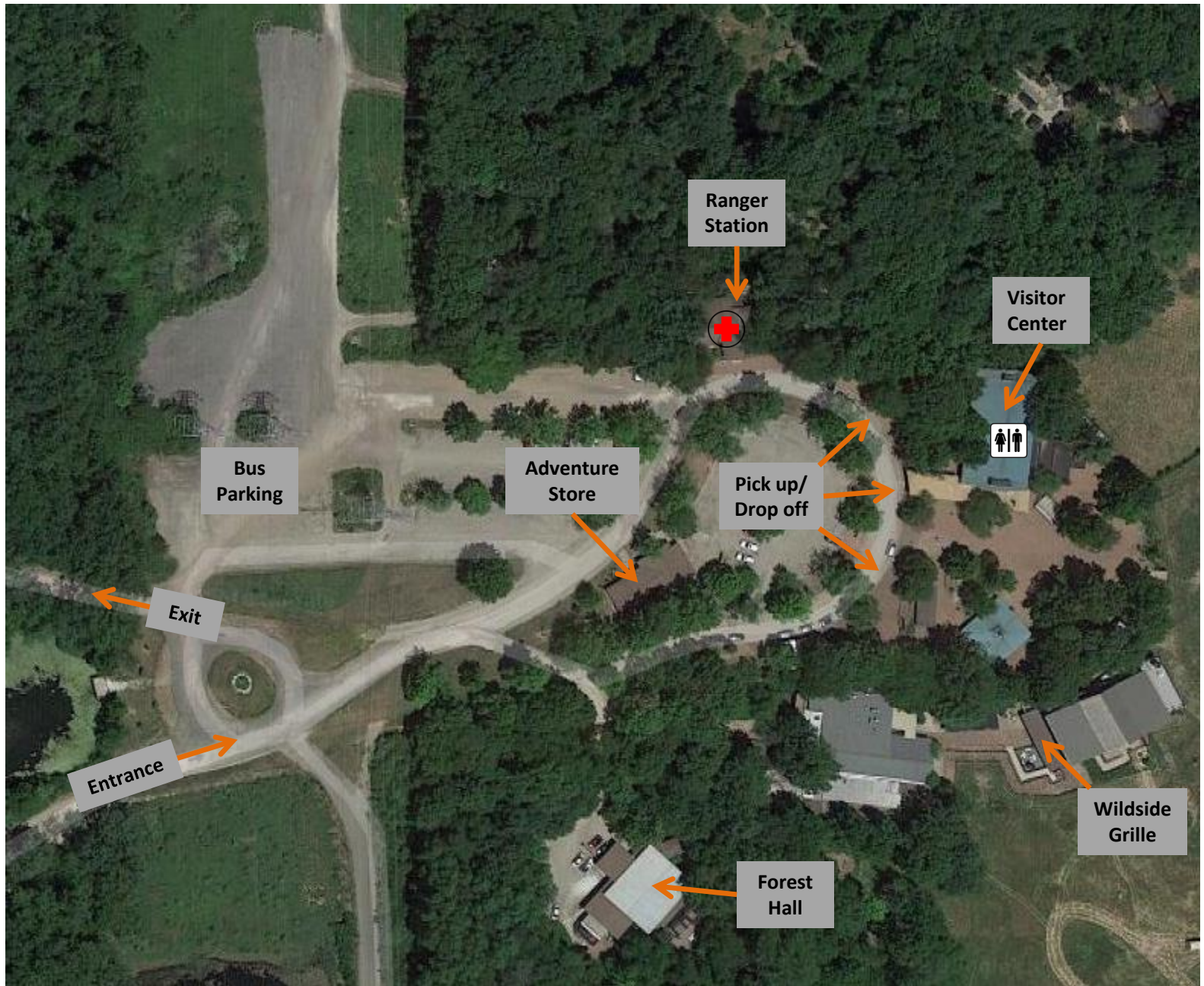
