This seasonal part-time position primarily focuses on preparing, cleaning, and servicing all lodging units for public rental while assisting custodians as needed. Housekeepers report to the Housekeeping Manager.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Preparing and setting up all lodging units for public rental.
- Cleaning and servicing all lodging units to Wildlife Prairie Park standards.
- Sweeping, mopping, and maintaining all floor surfaces in lodging units.
- Cleaning and maintaining all furniture, linens, and room objects in lodging units.
- Performing laundry duties, including washing, and preparing all linens for reuse.
- Cleaning and maintaining restrooms and restroom facilities in lodging areas.
- Stocking and maintaining housekeeping supplies for lodging units.
- Reporting any maintenance-related issues in lodging units to the park operations staff.

- Assisting custodians as needed with special tasks or events.
- Conduct inventory of items in cabin between guests and report any missing items to Housekeeping Manager promptly.
- Supporting preparations and setup for special events, which may require flexible scheduling, including holidays.
- Attend meetings and professional development seminars/conferences.
- Other duties as assigned.
